#### **Official Rules**

1. This award is available to all National Quilting Association Certified Teachers whose NQA membership and update requirements remain current.
2. Nominations for the award will remain active for a period of one year.
3. Previous Certified Teacher of the Year award recipients are not eligible.
4. One teacher will be selected per year, provided the Evaluation Panel agrees that one nominee best meets the criteria. The honoree will be recognized at the NQA annual meeting.
5. This is not a monetary award.
6. NQA is not responsible for late, lost, mutilated, misdirected, illegible, incomplete, or postage-due nomination forms and supporting materials, or transmission failures owing to computer software, hardware, or Internet malfunctions.
7. Selection will be made by an Evaluation Panel, chaired by the Education Chairman. Selection criteria include teaching experience and competency, impact on the quilting community, and involvement in the NQA CT program.
8. All nomination and supporting materials become the property of NQA and will not be returned.

#### **Procedures**

1. Information regarding the process will be published at least annually in *The QQ*, and information regarding the process and the Class Evaluation Form for students to complete will be made available on the NQA website and in the CT newsletter, *Common Thoughts*.
2. Nomination forms, letters of recommendation, and evaluation forms will be sent to the NQA office and forwarded to the Education Chairman after the cut-off date.
3. Once the nominees have been verified as current members in good standing, the Education Chairman will forward copies of all nomination materials to the other two members of the Evaluation Panel who are appointed by the President – one previous award recipient and one member-at-large who is not a CT or CJ and has not studied with a teacher under consideration.
4. The panel will select a winner, provided one of the nominees meets the criteria. The award does not have to be given yearly.
5. The Education Chairman will notify the NQA President of the panel's decision. If there is an honoree, the Chairman will secure a suitable commemoration and present it to the honoree at the NQA Annual Meeting.
6. All nominations and supporting materials will be returned to the NQA office for filing.
7. The Education Chairman will insure that the honoree signs and returns the affidavit to the NQA office within 14 days after the announcement.

#### **Process**

1. Any student or employer of an NQA CT may nominate the CT for Teacher of the Year by mailing a completed nomination form with a letter of recommendation to the NQA office. Also included must be two additional letters of recommendation from two other employers, or Class Evaluation Forms from two additional students.
2. All nomination forms and supporting materials must be received in the NQA office by 3 p.m. EDT, March 31, 2010.
